

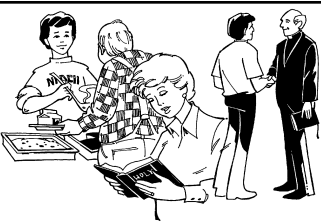
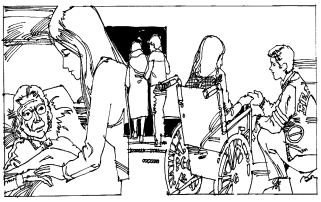
Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

The passage from Isaiah we hear today—of God’s servant suffering for the sins of others—we also heard on Good Friday and will hear again next Good Friday. Why do we hear it now nearly halfway in between the two? Perhaps it is because we can use the reminder of what Jesus has done for us. We can also be reminded of Jesus’ call to serve others. As we celebrate Mass today, let us renew our commitment to bring God’s word into action as we serve those who have the greatest need.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Despite their commitment to follow Jesus, the disciples often misunderstand the nature of their mission. Today we hear two of them focus on glory in heaven instead of service to others. Let us pray for an increased understanding ourselves of our mission as disciples. As we listen to God’s word, let us look to Jesus as an example and “find grace for timely help” (Hebrews 4:16).

Introducción a la Liturgia del Día

El pasaje de Isaías que escuchamos hoy nos habla del siervo de Dios que sufre por los pecados de la gente y es el mismo pasaje que escuchamos el pasado Viernes Santo, y que escucharemos de nuevo el Viernes Santo del año próximo. ¿Por qué lo escuchamos ahora, casi a mitad de camino entre los dos? Tal vez sea para que nos sirva de recordatorio de lo que Jesús ha hecho por nosotros. También puede ser un recordatorio de que estamos llamados a servir a los demás. En esta celebración de la Misa de hoy renovemos nuestro compromiso de poner en práctica la palabra de Dios en nuestro servicio a aquellas personas con mayores necesidades.

Introducción a la Liturgia de la Palabra

Los discípulos malentendieron a menudo la naturaleza de su misión, no obstante su compromiso de seguir a Jesús. Hoy oímos a dos de ellos poner su atención en su propia gloria en el cielo en lugar de concentrarse en servir a los demás. Oremos para que se nos conceda un mayor entendimiento de nuestra misión de discípulos. Al escuchar la palabra de Dios fijémonos en el ejemplo de Jesús para “hallar la gracia y obtener ayuda en el momento oportuno” (hebreos 4, 16).
